Pushing back is no longer a choice, but a necessity. Things will not improve unless we demand they do.

Ten's of thousands of people have recently lost their jobs due to Emperor Elon and First Moron Donald Jessica tRump. Let us be clear. NO ONE, is safe. Not you, not me not any of us.
